- 2. The **Outdoor Worship** experience allows new meaning to be given to the great hymns and passages of scripture which we enjoy and treasure.
- 3. The **Outdoor Worship** experience gives us the opportunity to observe our environs and take notice of the needs and concerns of the society.

On the Road to Synod

Provincial Synod 2019

Synod 2019 will get going with a 'Provincial Pre-Synod Meeting to facilitate a review and discussion of Synod reports and to provide pertinent information to delegates in order to expedite the business of the 32nd Provincial Synod when it convenes in July 2019'. This Pre-Synod meeting takes place via video conferencing on Saturday, June 8th. For this video conference, the Barbados delegation will meet at the DC Moore Centre, same as for the main Synod meeting in July.

From as early as July 12th, the delegates and observers of the 32nd Provincial Synod of the EWI Province will begin arriving on the island. There will be 80 official delegates to Synod, drawn from the six (6) Conferences, and the Grenada mission. Another 22 persons will accompany as observers. The Synod will commence with the Synod Retreat conducted by the Bishops, and the Opening Service on Monday, July 15th. The Service of Holy Communion and Installation of the PEC will officially conclude the Synod on July 18th.

Synod business will include the presentation, discussion and adoption of all synod reports, plus the discussion of the several proposal generated within the Conferences or at the Synod. These discussions will take place within eight Synod Committees as follows:

Celebrating Our Dads

As we celebrate FATHER'S DAY we as Christian bring to mind our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

Guidelines for the role of His Father are seen as He taught us how to pray (*Matt. 6:6-13*).

A Father is a co-partner in producing children from man and woman relationship. I have solicited and

obtained views on the roles and benefits of being a father and the importance of the father's contribution to their children's growth and development.

As Christian parents we must teach our children The Lord's Prayer

from their earliest stage of development: The Lord's Prayer provides us with the principle guideline for living and identity: the role of a father both on earth and in heaven.

Here are some ideas on fathering that have been shared by others:

- Treating your children as individuals as this helps to open them up to positive relationships, to develop their self-image and their level of independence;
- Their capacity to respect others and their differences and how to relate to siblings, other family members, the extended family and the wider community including the teachers in school, other children and the neighbours;
- Fathers, in collaboration with mothers, teach them skills for living and relating to others the "PLEASE" and "THANK YOU", the "I LOVE YOU", and other social graces necessary to live with others people;.
- Fathers also teach their children skills for living and relating to others, self-image/respect and self-sufficiency, helpfulness at home, school, and in the community;
- Fathers and mothers must agree on how to deal with the care, development and guidance of their children. Both parents must teach their children how to resolve conflicts in a satisfactory manner. Both parents and particularly the father must teach their children about consequences of their actions and behaviours.

My own father and grandfather taught me the following:

- Punctuality;
- ➤ How to give from the heart;
- Generosity/Sharing;
- ➤ Worshipping together;
- ➤ Doing special things for the family e.g. baking muffins;
- > Problem solving;
- ➤ How to have a positive self-image, self-esteem and self-respect; -
- How to care for and help others unselfishly;
- The consequences of inappropriate behaviour e.g. lying, stealing, being untidy, disobedience, selfishness;
- ➤ How to choose friends and company;
- ➤ How to have fun and enjoy yourself.

We thank God for our fathers and the roles they have performed and shared with us towards our development as responsible citizens in God's kingdom.


